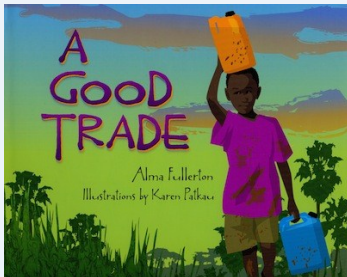




# Resources to Extend the Introductions of Blue Spruce Books 2014 In Your Classroom!



**Themes:** A look at life in Uganda, perhaps in a refugee camp?

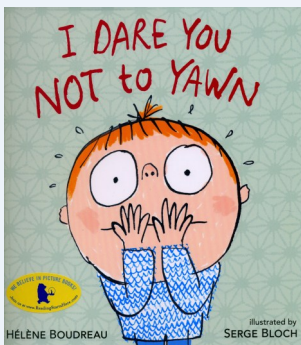
Inferencing activities galore!

What do the pictures tell you about life in Uganda? Compare your life to their life

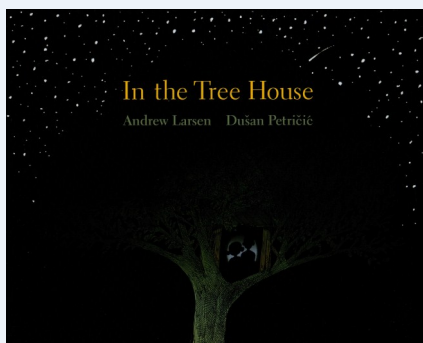
**Note for Teachers:** Beware the “One Story!” Is this the only way people in Uganda live?

**Themes:** nature, community, plans & connecting

A boy finally gets his own tree house & over time notices isolation from stars (light pollution) & community (everyone in house with air-conditioning, computers and tv) until the power outage!

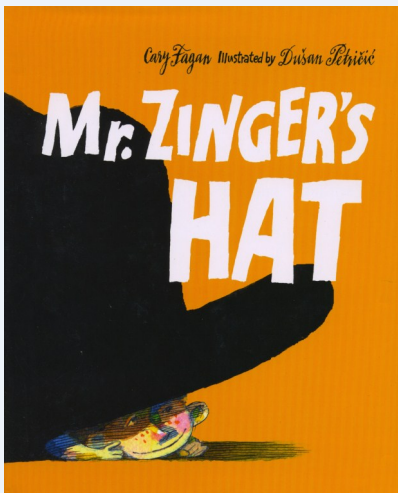
Extensions:

CURRENTLY IN DISCUSSION WITH AUTHOR ABOUT AN AUTHOR VISIT!

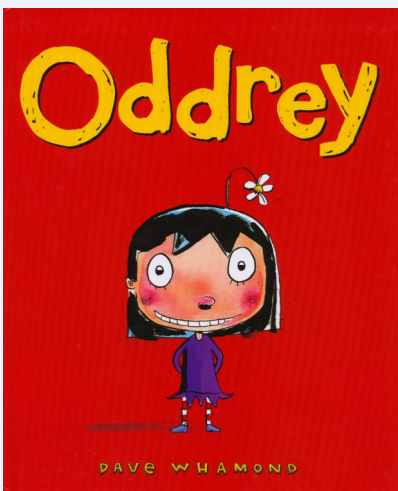


**Themes:** Creativity, Where do stories come from? Neighbours

Leo's ball hits his author neighbour and starts a conversation that it seems Leo will never forget as they discover the magic of building a story together.

Extension: Grab a book & read the first line. Have students play "Pass the story" and add to the story until they create a totally different one based on another.

Could be fun to have the teacher type the story as they tell it and compare the original & the classes.

Dave Whamond is an author/illustrator & has created a character who does things her own way & over time receives recognition and recognition.

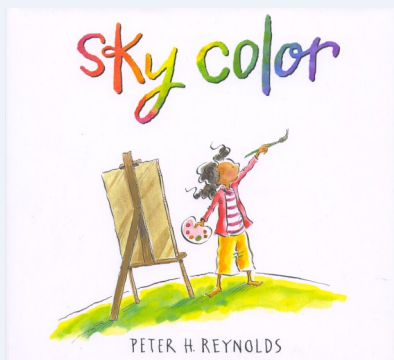
Extension:

Although the video is great with an excellent message, make sure it's on full screen due to interesting videos around it.



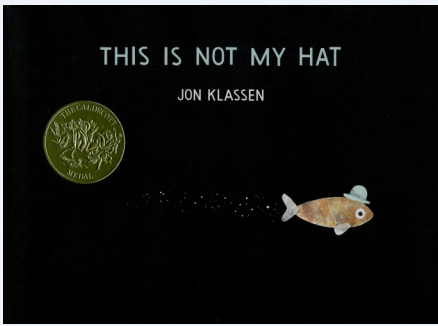
**Themes:** Creativity, Authentic Self & Ways of Seeing

Extension: Students could examine the sky over different day & paint a sky the way they see it. It would be cool to have a display "My Sky is..."

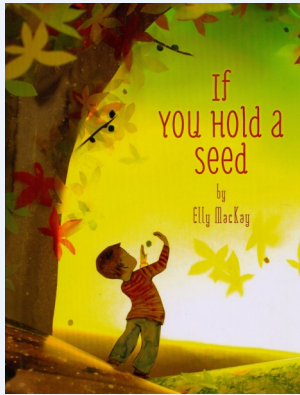


**Themes :** Justice & Justifications

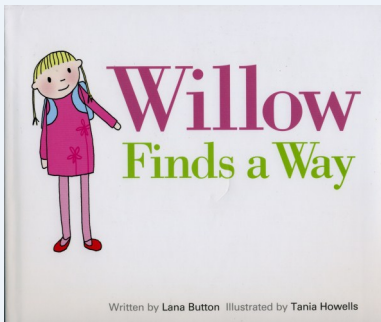
A classic tale with classic illustrations. If the hat doesn't belong to the small fish, who does it belong to & why does he have it? Who wants it back?

**Themes:** plants, life cycles, seasons, habitats

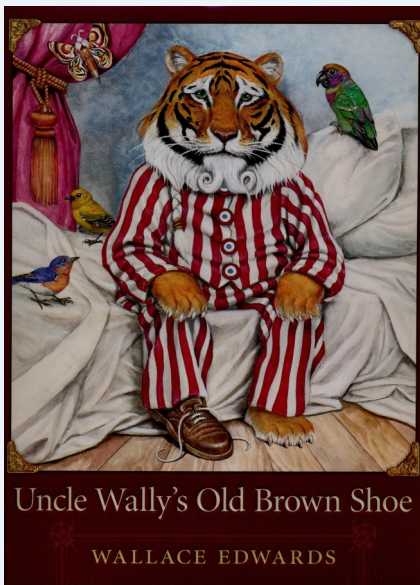

**Themes:** Upstanding , Exclusion as a bullying tactic

**Themes:** Creativity, Word Choice, Active Verbs

Extension:

Have your students pick 8 active verbs and 8 nouns.
